RIALACHA

1. Age as at 1st January 2009
2. Entries only accepted from teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha.
3. Traditional Set Dances : St Patrick's Day, The Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Jockey to the Fair, 3 Sea Captains.
4. To enter a Preliminary Competition, dancers must have been eligible to enter Mean Grad for those particular dances on January 1st 2009. Preliminary Championships are confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize in a Preliminary Championship or in an Open Championship adjudicated by a minimum of three adjudicators. Dancers who have attained a World medal may not compete. Winning a Preliminary Championship deems the dancer ineligible to dance in Mean Grad for the two dances performed in that age group. In the event that a dancer entered in the Preliminary Championship wins the Open Championship the next placed preliminary dancer will be deemed winner of the Preliminary Championship. The onus is on the teacher to indicate clearly at the time of entry, the dancers eligible for preliminary championship. The Leinster Dance Teachers' Association cannot accept responsibility for teachers' errors.
5. Dancing is only permitted in the designated Practice Areas.
6. The Committee as far as is practicable, will provide a floor surface suitable for dancing. However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage, or within the practice area. The lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by a dancer and by her/his parent/guardian.
7. No block, en pointe be it stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including under 12 age group. However according to An Coimisiun rule, dancers who will compete under 13 from 1st January 2010 may perform en pointe movements from September 2009.
8. The use of artificial carriage aids is strictly forbidden. Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same, will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed apparatus (proof of which may be required) will be exempt from this ruling.
9. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion using electronic/manual means e.g. mobile phones, video, still camera, commercial film with/without a flash enhancement or any other means of recording is strictly prohibited.
10. Parents are responsible for the conduct and behaviour of their children at all times whilst attending the Feis and within and around the Hotel Complex.
11. Adjudicator's decision is final. Objections must be lodged in writing within 1 hour of the announcement of a result of a competition and accompanied by a fee of €20.00. Committee members only may approach the adjudicators.
12. An Coimisiun rules will apply if disputes arise that are not covered by the above rules.
13. The Feis Committee reserves the right to (A) use relief adjudicators or musicians, (B) Alternate competitions if to do so is necessary to maintain the smooth running of the feis.
14. Craobh Comortaisi under 7 and 7-8 all dancers must dance Reel, Light Jig, and Slip Jig or Single Jig. Craobh Comortas 8 to 9 years all dancers must dance Reel, Jig, and Traditional Set Dance. In all other Craobh Comortaisi all dancers will dance a Light Dance, Heavy Dance and Recall Set Dance.
15. Boys championships will be double ages unless there are more than 3 in each age group.
